

PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING FOOD HANDLERS CERTIFICATE

Register at any of the following sanitation offices with two (2) passport size photographs.

- ❖ Env. Health & Sanitation Unit (Head Office)
- ❖ Madina Zonal Council Office
- ❖ Oyarifa Zonal Council Office
- ❖ Madina Market Sanitation Office

Obtain a food handlers medical screening form for laboratory examination and conduct a test in Tuberculosis and Typhoid Fever at an accredited laboratory or health facility.

Submit the medical examination report to the head office

Persons medically fit are issued with health certificate of fitness within a period of one week at a cost of ₦50 per health certificate.

Medically unfit persons are directed to stop handling food for public consumption and undergo medical treatment.

Treated persons then undergo a review to be declared fit before being issued with health certificates.

Health certificates are renewed annually through the same procedure.

The public is hereby reminded that it is an offence under section (2) of LaNMMA Sanitation bye-law 2017 to handle, cook, prepare, bake or sell any food or alcoholic beverage without a health certificate of fitness.
